



Student Work Opportunities - Frequently Asked Questions

I'm an international student. Can I still apply for these jobs?

Because payment for these jobs is considered a "tuition discount" and is tax-exempt, international students should be able to work. However, we always recommend consulting your international student advisor at your year-round institution if they are sponsoring your residency in the United States.

How and when do I get paid?

You will need to complete weekly timesheets through your [Student Portal](#) to report your hours. Your manager will review and confirm your hours worked. Checks will be distributed on the [Paycheck Distribution Schedule](#) in the Student Handbook.

Will these jobs fit into my musical schedule?

In Aspen, your musical commitments take priority! It is your responsibility to schedule shifts that do not conflict with your studies. Don't worry - the hiring managers know that you are busy and here to learn. Enterprising students have worked anywhere from 5 to 20 hours per week, depending on availability.

Can I have more than one job?

Sure - if you plan carefully and are realistic about your schedule, you may apply for more than one position.

Awesome. How do I apply?

You can apply for work opportunities pre-season and during summer through your [Student Portal](#). Once you log into your Portal, look for the "Student Work Opportunities" section to complete the desired application. Managers will receive your application and contact you about available positions. Please note any early deadlines included on the application form.

STUDENT WORK OPPORTUNITIES

Several student work opportunities are available this summer. Positions include Library Assistants, Ushers, Traffic Control and Parking Crew, Mail Room Assistant, Accompanying and Page Turning.
